

The Ollie's Bag

The Ollie's bag was specially designed for a local cafe, Ollie's Cafe & Grocer, that also sells sour dough bread and other grocery items. This market bag will have everyone asking you where you got it from. It will be great in any colour combination to suit your mood.

Difficulty and Terminology:

This is an easy pattern and uses US terminology.

What You Will Need:

5 mm hook
2 balls Patons Cotton Blend 8 ply
Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Tension:

20 sts/8 rows = 10cm/4 inches square in dc

Sizing:

The finished bag is 11 cm wide and 9.5 cm long.

Abbreviations:

ch - chain
sc - single crochet
tr - treble crochet
fhdc - foundation half double crochet
slst - slip stitch
sk - skip
st - stitch



The Bag:

Each round is joined with a slipstitch.

To Begin

Round 1: ch4, work 11 dc into 4th ch from hook, join with slip stitch; (12 dc)

Round 2: ch3, work 1 dc into same st as join, then 2dc in each dc around, join with slip stitch; (24 dc)

Round 3: ch3, work 1 dc into same st as join, dc in next st, *2dc into next dc, then 1 dc into next dc*, repeat from * to * to end, join with slip stitch; (36 dc)

Round 4: ch3, work 1 dc into same st as join, dc in next 2 st, *2dc into next dc, then 1 dc into next 2 dc*, repeat from * to * to end, join with slip stitch; (48 dc)

Round 5: ch5, work 1 tr into same st as join, *skip st, (tr, ch 1, tr) into next stitch, ch1*, repeat from * to *, join with slipstitch; (24 V stitches)

Round 6 - 17: slst into ch1 space, ch5, work 1 tr into same ch1 space, ch1, sk ch1 space (tr, ch 1, tr) into each ch1 space of elongated V around, join with slip stitch; (24 elongated V stitches)

Round 18: ch1, 2 sc in ch1 space of elongated V, and sc in each ch1 space between elongated V's, around, join with slst; (72 sc)

Round 19: ch1, sc into first 9 sc, fhdc or ch 40, skip 18 sc, sc in next 18 sc, fhdc or ch 40, skip 18 sc, sc in next 9 sc, join with slst;

Round 20: ch1, sc in each stitch around, join with slst.

Finishing

Fasten off and weave in ends.
