

# Umbrella Coasters

One thing I really enjoy crocheting is coasters. I also really like crocheting from charts. The obvious thing to do was combine the two, and voila we have umbrella coasters.

These will be great in any colour combination to suit your decor or theme for a party. Try blues and greys to reflect a rainy day.

## Difficulty and Terminology:

This is an easy pattern and uses US terminology.

## What You Will Need:

1 ball 4 Seasons Flinders 8ply Cotton in hot pink  
1 ball 4 Seasons Flinders 8ply Cotton in olive green  
3.25 mm hook  
Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

## Tension:

20 sts/14 rows = 10cm/4 inches square in esc

## Sizing:

The finished coaster is 11cm wide and 9.5 cm long.

## Abbreviations:

ch - chain

esc - extended single crochet
