Crochet to Enhance Your World

No Sew Baby Booties

Baby booties that are worked in the round and do not need to be sewn together.

Quick to work up and colour changes can be used to give different looks and make booties to coordinate with every outfit. Match with the basic baby hat or the strawberry shortcake hat and the baby armour vest in the colours of your choice to make a matching set that will make baby stand out from the crowd.

This pattern is worked in the round.

This pattern is written only.

I used 4 seasons Pure Wool 8ply, but any 8ply yarn will work with this pattern.

Difficulty and Terminology:

This is an intermediate pattern and uses US terminology.

What You Will Need:

1 ball double knit (8 ply) weight yarn (50g) in colour of your choice

5 mm crochet hook

Tapestry needle (to weave in ends)

Tension:

14 sts/17 rounds = 10cm/4 inches square in sc turning/without turning at the end of each round

Sizing:

The bootie will be approx. 10cm long

Abbreviations:

ch - chain

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

dc2tog - double crochet two together (decrease stitch)

blo - back loop only

slst - slip stitch

The Booties:

To begin, ch 8

Row 1: 2 dc in 3rd ch from hook, dc in next 4 ch, 6 dc in last ch. dc in next 4 ch on opposite side, with 3dc in last stitch, join with slst. ch 1 (20 dc)

Row 2: 2 hdc in same st as join, hdc in next 7 dc, 2 hdc in next dc, 3 hdc in next dc, 2 hdc in next dc, hdc in next 7 dc, 2 hdc in next 2 dc, join with slst. ch 1 (27 hdc)

Row 3: crocheting in back loop only (blo), sc in each hdc, join with slst. ch 1 (27 sc)

Row 4 & 5: sc in each sc, join with slst. ch 1 (27 sc)

Row 6: sc in next 9 sc, [dc2tog] 4 times, sc in next 10 sc, join with slst. ch 1 (23 stitches)

Row 7: sc in next 9dc, [dc2tog] 2 times, sc in next 10 sc, join with slst. ch 1 (21 stitches)

Row 8: sc in each stitch, join with slst. ch 1 (21 sc)

Row 9 - 11: hdc in each hdc, join with slst. ch 1 (21 hdc)

Row 12: slst in each st around, join with slst. (21 slst)

Make two.

Finishing

Fasten off and weave in ends
